HARMONY ROAD CLASSES & CAMPS

NOTE: A placement “audition” for all Rock Band Camp participants will be held on Wednesday, June 23, 2010 beginning at 12:00pm. Students are asked to play the chorus of one tune and will be quizzed on basic knowledge of music theory and chords. Sessions could be combined or extended depending on the number of students.

MUSICAL THEATER CAMPS

Meridian Music’s musical theater camps give all students regardless of experience or skill level the chance to experience several aspects of Musical Theatre. Students experience theatre terminology, the parts of the stage, character development, vocal projection, costuming, makeup, and set design. Students use these new skills in a performance on the last evening of camp.
